Statements were taken of the applicants: no material discrepancies in same. The mercantile status of alleged father and husband respectively of applicants 1615 and 1617 was established prior to his departure, Serial 158. The essential trip of No. 1618 covering the son, No. 1615, is No. 80 "Rio", Nov. 17, 1897, when the alleged father made his original entry into this country as a Section 6 merchant.

Applicant No. 1617 is a bound-footed woman and has all the appearance of respectability. I recommend landing for these applicants.


